Getting to SFU Woodward's

Public Transit, Parking and Valet Parking Service Information

SFU Woodward's will open to the public in January 2010 and its Inaugural Program of theatre, dance and visual arts presentations will unfold between January and June 2010. Programming in February and March will coincide with the 2010 Vancouver Olympic and Paralympic Games, when special transportation measures will be in effect in the downtown area and driving and parking will be restricted. SFU Woodward's will still be accessible and the following transit and parking information should help patrons make their way more easily to the facility and its events.

SFU Woodward's main entrance is located at **149 West Hastings St.** in downtown Vancouver. There is also access to the **Fei and Milton Wong Experimental Theatre** from the Woodward's Atrium courtyard entrance at the corner of West Cordova and Cambie St.

By car

There is an EasyPark lot located on Cordova St. across the street from the Atrium entrance, between Cambie and Abbott.

By transit

SFU Woodward's is located on a major bus route and within easy walking distance of SkyTrain and SeaBus. Plan your transit trip at www.translink.ca or call **604.953.3333**.

It's recommended that during the 2010 Winter Olympics you make use of the enhanced transit service throughout the downtown core and surrounding areas. Check the Translink website for details on any Olympic-related route changes.

- From **East Vancouver**: take the #10 Granville (from Kootenay Loop); #8 Downtown (Fraser); or #20 Downtown (Victoria Drive).
- From **South Vancouver**: take the #3 Downtown (Main and Marine); or #16 Arbutus (29th Ave Station).
- From **Richmond and Vancouver's west side**: take the Canada Line.
- From **Port Coquitlam, Coquitlam and Port Moody**: take the #160 Vancouver.
- From **North Burnaby**: take the #135 Burrard Station.
- From **North Vancouver**: take the SeaBus.
- From **West Vancouver**: take any Blue Bus into downtown Vancouver to its terminus.
- From **Surrey and New Westminster**: Take SkyTrain.

Valet Parking

Valet Parking for patrons of SFU Woodward's **Vancouverism: City Salon events (Jan. 14 & 15)** and **The Blue Dragon (Feb. 2-27)** will be available through our partners from EasyPark. You can purchase valet parking service ahead of time by phoning **604-873-3311** and you will be mailed a parking voucher and specific instructions on how to access the service. Valet parking will be at the Cordova St. EasyPark lot, located between Cambie and Abbott and directly across from the Atrium entrance to SFU Woodward's.
